

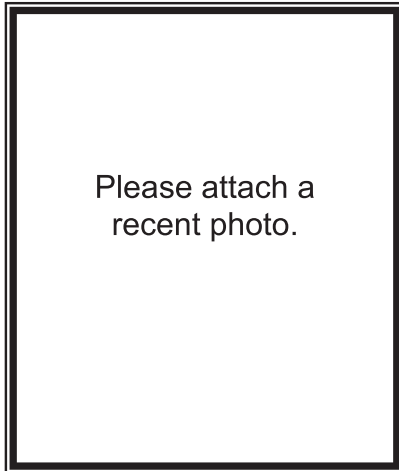

Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or GED recipient applying as a full time student to an accredited college or university, or a freshman year college student at an accredited college or university. Must be a US Citizen and resident of the County of Kauai, State of Hawaii. Applicants must be pursuing a formal education focused on the performing arts such as theatre arts, music, dance, or stagecraft.

Required Documents:

Include a copy of your high school or first year college transcript, two typed, formal letters of recommendation (one from a current or former teacher and one from a member of the community), and a copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) or Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form (if applicable).

Selection Criteria: The scholarship is administered without regard to race, creed, color, age, religion, sex, national origin, or physical disability. The committee will consider the following:

- Performing Arts Achievement/Experience
- Academic Achievement
- Talent
- Financial Need

Applicant Interviews: The top three applicants must be available to be interviewed from April 15 to May 10.

Scholarship Amount - \$1,000: Scholarship awards will be announced by May 15, 2018 and paid directly to the college you plan to attend.
